



Dual Degree Program IN SOCIAL WORK AND MARRIAGE AND FAMILY SERVICES (MSW/MS)

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Through the dual degree program of the School of Social Work (SSW) and the Department of Human and Community Development (HCD), students gain theoretical knowledge and research competency related to family development, family systems, and family problems, as well as practical skills in counseling troubled families. The Dual Degree program can be completed in 2.5 to 3 years (88–96 credit hours) depending on the area of specialization and undergraduate major. Students in the dual degree program must choose a specialization (Advocacy, Leadership, and Social Change; Child Welfare, Community Mental Health; Health Care; or School Social Work) once enrolled in the School of Social Work. Generally, coursework during the first year fulfills the HCD requirements, and second-year coursework fulfills the SSW requirements.

DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university
 - A minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) or better for the last sixty (60) semester hours or ninety (90) quarter hours of coursework
 - GRE score of 500 or better
 - Twenty (20) hours of completed coursework in social and behavioral sciences
 - Evidence of personal attributes that are suitable for the profession of social work
 - Experience in human services (paid, volunteer, and/or internship)
- International students must also include:**
- TOEFL score of 520 on the paper-and-pencil exam or 237 on the computer-based exam
 - Financial certification
